## Introduction:

17 But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, reasonable, full of mercy and good fruits, unwavering, without hypocrisy. 18 And the seed whose fruit is righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

1. PURE = *But the wisdom from above is first pure*

1 John 3:3 everyone who has this hope fixed on Him purifies himself, just as He is pure

Hebrews 12:14 sanctification ... no one will see the Lord

Matthew 5:8 Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God

2. PEACEABLE = *then peaceable*

Matthew 5:9 Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God

The truly wise don't enact conflict through selfishness; they engender peace through humility

Man's wisdom says to cover up sin to make peace. God's wisdom says to confess sin to make peace

Romans 12:18 If possible, so far as it depends on you, be at peace with all men

Ephesians 4:26 Do not let the sun go down on your anger

3. GENTLE

Matthew 5:39-40 I say to you, do not resist an evil person; but whoever slaps you on your right cheek, turn the other to him also. If anyone wants to sue you and take your shirt, let him have your coat also.

The gentle person does not deliberately cause fights, but neither does he compromise the truth in order to keep peace

Isaiah 42:3 A bruised reed He will not break. And a dimly burning wick He will not extinguish

2 Timothy 2:24-25 the Lord's bond-servant must not be quarrelsome, but be kind to all, able to teach, patient when wronged with GENTLENESS correcting those who are in opposition, if perhaps God may grant them repentance leading to the knowledge of the truth.

#### 4. REASONABLE

You want what's right more than what you want

Reasonable wisdom will choose principle over preference

#### 5. MERCIFUL = full of mercy

Mercy implies looking on somebody with compassion when they deserve punishment

**Matthew 5:7** Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy

**Luke 6:36** Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful

#### 6. BOUNTIFUL = full of...good fruits


**John 15:16** You did not choose Me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and that your fruit would remain,

#### 7. UNWAVERING

#### 8. SINCERE = without hypocrisy

**Ephesians 4:15** speaking the truth in love

Wherever you find God's people pretending and hiding, you can be sure the wisdom of this world is governing their ministry



### 3<sup>rd</sup> The C \_\_\_\_\_ of true wisdom 18

**18** And the seed whose fruit is righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

If you claim to have wisdom like you should, then why do you live like you shouldn't?

#### TAKE HOME:

A. Like faith without works is dead, so wisdom without Christlike \_\_\_\_\_ is empty

**Ephesians 1:17** that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you a spirit of wisdom
